

Sir Edward Youde Memorial (SEYM) Scholarships for Overseas Studies 2022/23
&
Overseas Scholarship for Disabled Students 2022/23 (for current Form 5
students)

Aim

The Sir Edward Youde Memorial Scholarships for Overseas Studies & Overseas Scholarship for Disabled Students aim at financing outstanding students and outstanding disabled students for overseas undergraduate studies. Successful candidates will be those with excellent scholastic achievements and strong leadership abilities demonstrated in their extra-curricular activities. They are expected to have a strong sense of commitment to Hong Kong and should be ready to contribute significantly to the society after graduation from overseas studies.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- A. be permanent residents of Hong Kong;
- B. have received at least five years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong;
- C. fulfill all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of their choices and be offered places subsequently; and
- D. be proficient in English and Chinese, and have a good mastery of the language in which their studies will be undertaken.

Those who expect to commence full-time postgraduate or undergraduate studies in any tertiary educational and / or academic institution outside Hong Kong in the 2022/23 academic year and who meet the eligibility criteria set out in this Information Note may apply. For further details, please refer to the Information Note of the application year.

Value of Awards

The maximum is HK\$280,000 per year. The Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fund Council may adjust downward the value by taking into account the actual university fees, necessary living expenses and other award(s) held concurrently by the scholar(s) to finance their overseas studies.
