### Plan on the Use of the Grant (2025-2026)

## **Background and Curriculum Review**

Ever since the implementation of the School Development Plan 2022-2025 and the English Implementation Plan 2022-2025, various strategies have been deployed to facilitate self-directed learning in school. From the establishment and the fine-tuning of the Junior Form Self-Access Learning Portfolio, and the design and/or enhancement of pre-learning tasks in junior and senior forms and reflective notes on reading in Form 4, to the tryout on reflective strategies in Form 6 writing encompassing goal-setting and individualized proofreading checklists and the use of OneNote and Google Classroom in BYOD, there is no shortage of self-directed learning strategies, teaching packages, and resources in the English curriculum. In addition, the English Panel has also involved the use of AI in speaking and a variety of vocabulary consolidation games (Quizziz, Quizlet, WordWall, crossword puzzles etc.), not to mention the use of DSE purchased scripts to compile samples for students' self-access / teachers' use.
